HOW TO GROW A SPEKBOOM



A step-by-step guide



TRIM A CUTTING

Trim about 10-50 cm of a stem from the Spekboom using a clean, sharp knife



LEAVE TO DRY

Leave this to dry for a day or two

REMOVE SOME LEAVES

Remove the leaves from the bottom third of the cutting

PLACE IN SOIL




Place the cutting in a soil mix for succulents or cacti up to where the leaves start



WATER IT

Water the planted cutting


WAIT



Wait for the cutting to root and follow the care guidelines below



HOW TO TAKE CARE OF A SPEKBOOM FOR CLIMENTS Astep-by-step guide



GIVE IT SUN

Spekboom thrive in sunny areas so place your Spekboom somewhere where it gets enough light





WATER IT

- In hot, dry conditions: Water your Spekboom once a week
- In rainy conditions: Only water your Spekboom if the leaves are shrivelled

PRUNE IT

Use a clean blade to trim your Spekboom into the shape you desire if the stems get too

long



FERTILIZE IT Spekboom plants do not need fertilizer to survive but will thrive off a balanced fertilizer once a month

REPOT IT

Your Spekboom plant does not need to be repotted regularly, however, roots 'circling' around the bottom of the pot is an indication that it is needed — but only by a few centimeters
